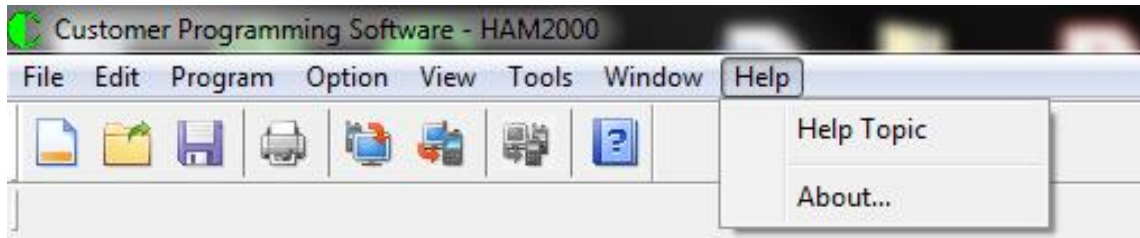
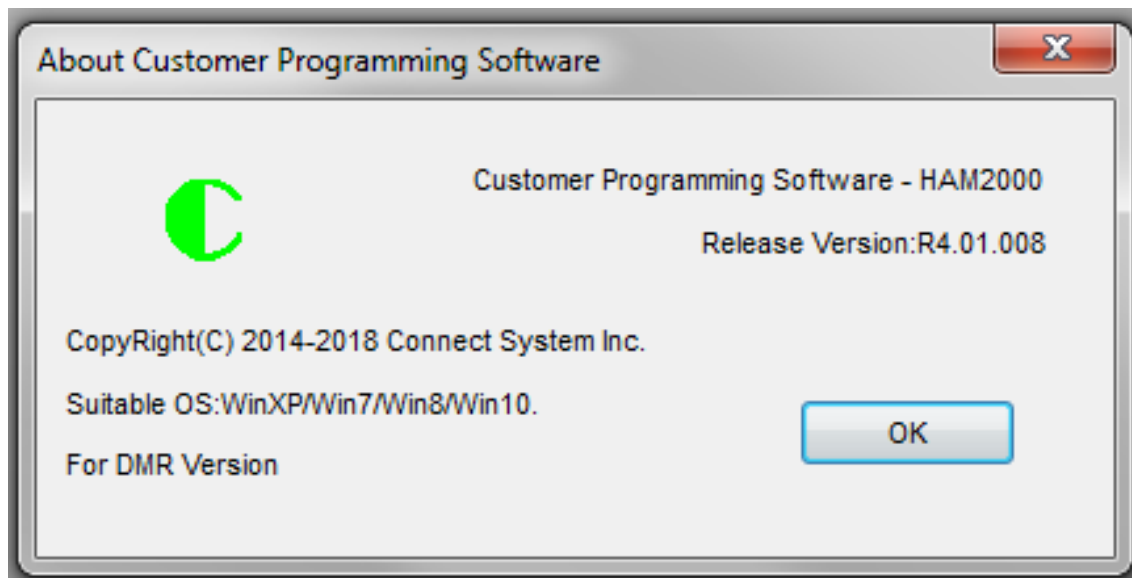


Make sure you have the latest CPS. You can find the version in the Help pull down menu and click on “About”.

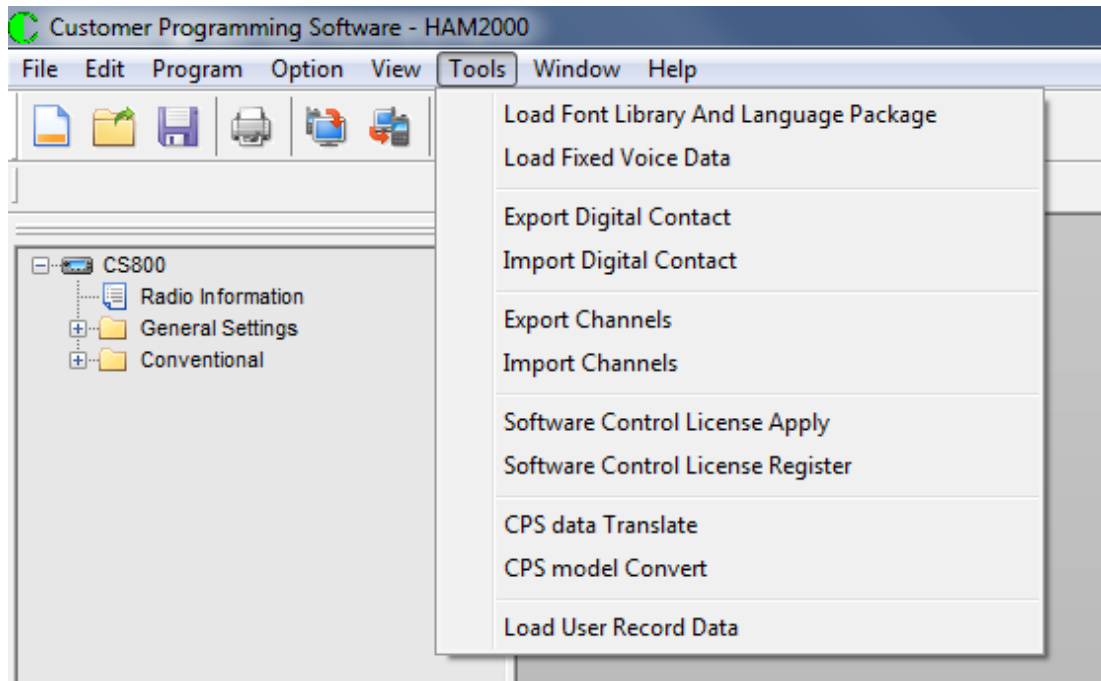


When you press the “About” entry you get:

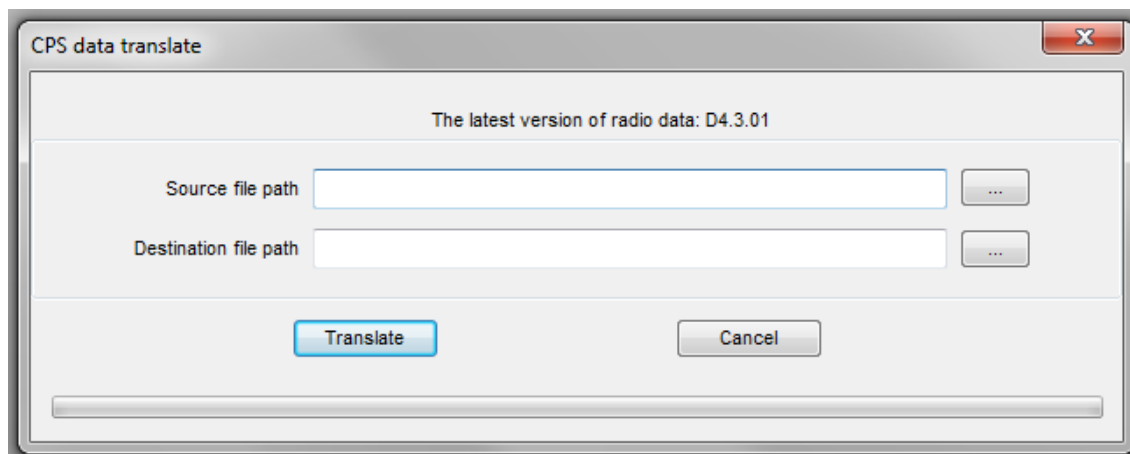


Make sure the Release Version is the one you want.

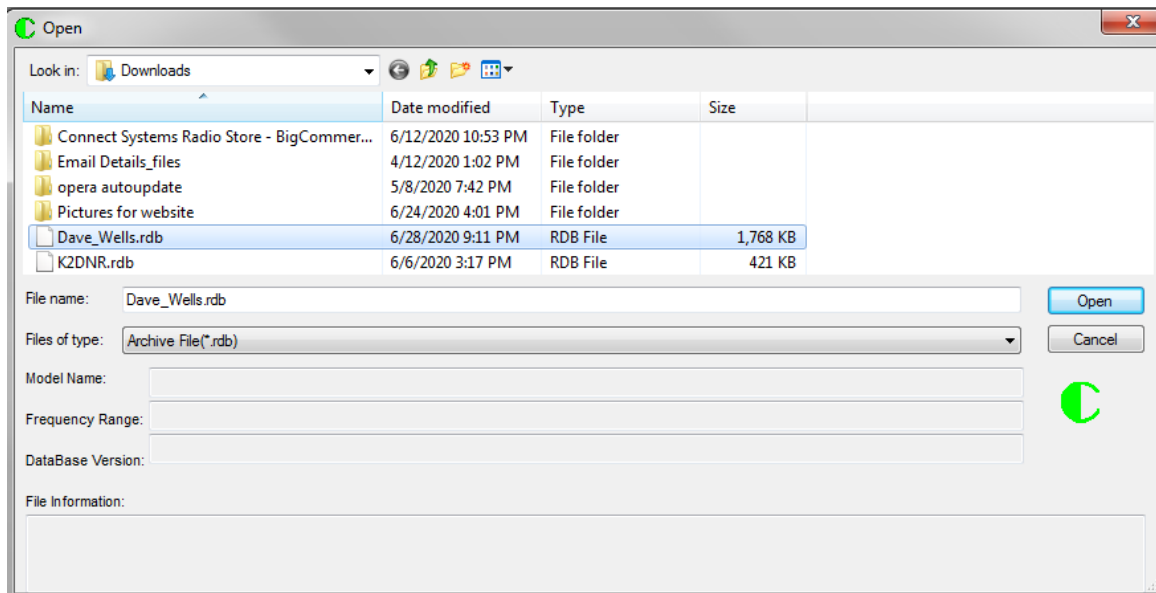
Now go to the Tools Pulldown menu and press “CPS Data Translate”.



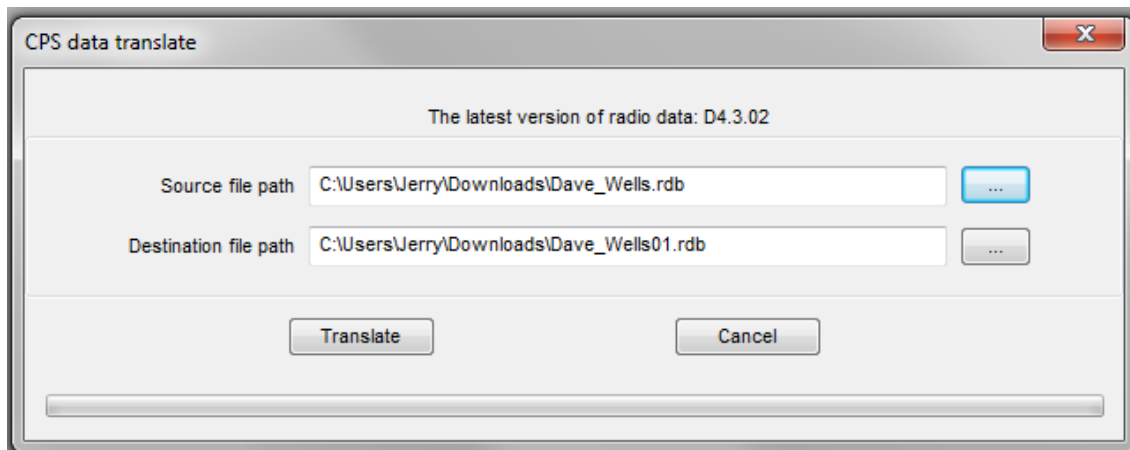
When you press “CPS Data Translate” you get:



Now press the button with the “...” next to the Source file path and you will get:

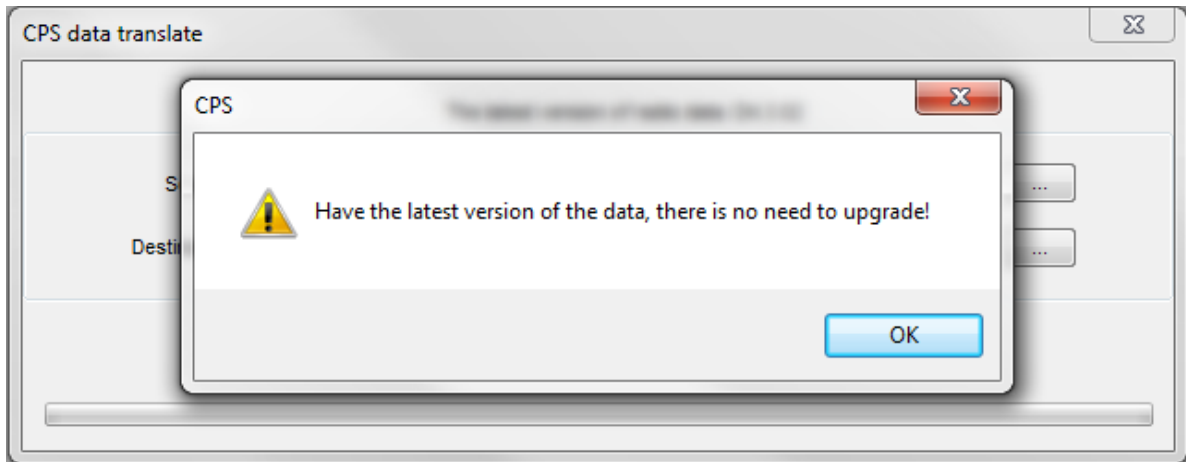


Locate your code plug you want to update and then double click on that file. You will then get:

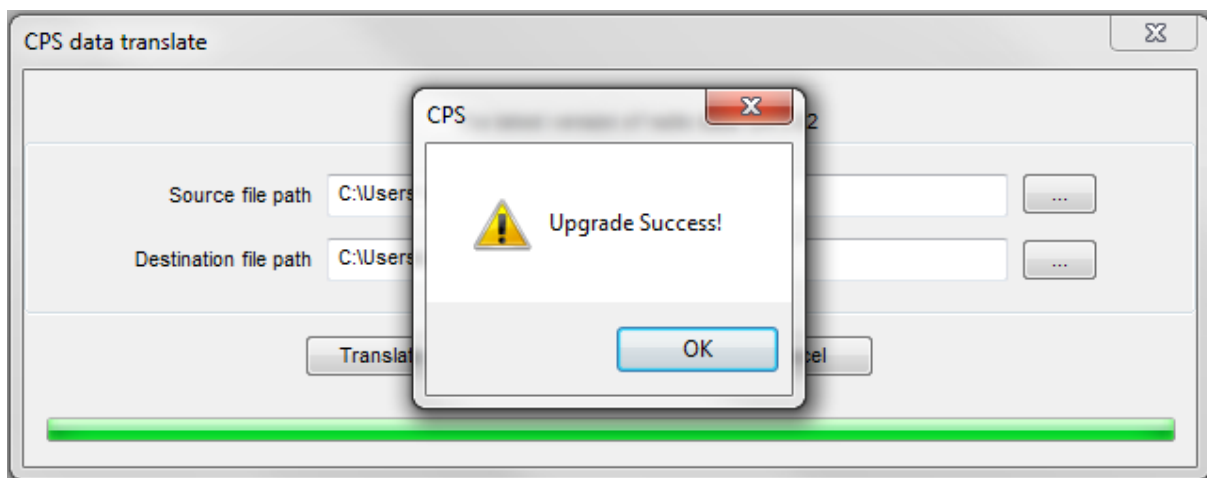


Notice the program automatically generates a destination file path and file name. The original file is not modified.

Press the “Translate” key and you will get:



In this case the file was already updated and there was no need to do anything. However, if the file was not the latest, then you will get the following message:



Having the message where it says there is no need to upgrade might be a problem if your original file was from a code plug that was created awhile back.
